## **ADMISSION CRITERIA**

In order to gain admission to this programme you need one of the following qualifications:

- Italian bachelor degree (old or new system)
- University diploma
- Foreign qualification obtained abroad and recognized as suitable

### **Curricular requirements:**

- 1) The admission requirements are:
  - a. an Italian bachelor's degree in the degree class L-9 (Industrial Engineering) ex D.M. 270/2004
  - b. an Italian bachelor's degree in the degree class 10 (Industrial Engineering) ex D.M. 509/1999
  - c. an Italian degree in another degree class (old or new system), university diploma or other foreign qualification gained abroad and recognized as suitable.
- 2) In the first two cases mentioned above (1a and 1b), you must also have acquired the number of ECTS credit points needed for the Italian degree Laurea in Ingegneria Industriale (class L-9, DM n. 2359, 16 March 2007):
  - Min. 36 ECTS credit points () in the scientific-disciplinary areas of basic subjects.
  - Min. 45 ECTS credit points in the scientific-disciplinary areas of the characterizing subjects of industrial mechanical engineering
- 3) In the third case mentioned above (1c), the Admissions Committee will check the requirements to determine whether the contents and courses attended are equivalent to the disciplinary fields mentioned at point (2). If you have gained a foreign qualification, the number of credit points awarded to scientific disciplinary sectors will be based on the contents of the exams passed.
- 4) If you do not have the necessary curricular requirements, you will not be admitted if your average grade in the bachelor (not including the final exam) is lower than 22/30 (Italian system) or 3,0 (German system)

If you have not yet graduated at the time of application: you can apply if you have acquired at least 150 ECTS credit points. Until your graduation, you will be admitted conditionally. You must have achieved your degree by the enrolment deadline, otherwise you will be excluded.

To be admitted you must fulfil the language requirements indicated in the section "Language requirements".

### **Requirements for the Double Degree Programme:**

In order to gain access to the Double Degree Programme, you need to certify also:

- 1) 25 credit points within the competence of science and computer science (including at least 15 credits in Mathematics / statistics and 5 credits in Computer Science)
- 2) at least 20 credit points in the engineering competence (at least 10 credits in Mechanics and 5 in Construction)
- 3) at least 10 credit points in Economics
- 4) at least 15 credit points in logistics and production management (logistics, traffic engineering, production planning and control)

At the end of the 3rd semester, you must have passed the exams of the 1st semester and document at least 10 weeks of internship in the industrial sector.

If you do not fulfil the requirements in time, you will not be able to graduate with the Double Degree.

The official teaching language is English. Therefore, the following language requirements apply, otherwise you will be excluded from the admission procedure:

### **Entry level (to gain admission):**

English: B2

The levels of the Common European Framework of Reference apply.

### **Ranking lists:**

The Admission Committee will only evaluate the documents uploaded in the portal by the application deadline.

The general ranking list includes all students who submitted the application for the master.

The second ranking list includes only the students who express their interest in attending the Double Degree Program with Otto von Guericke University Magdeburg (OVGU) through the application portal.

Students on the waiting list of the ranking for the double degree programme with Otto von Guericke University Magdeburg (OVGU) of the Early Bird Application will be inserted in the ranking list for the double degree programme of the Late Application (only for those who secured their admission; see chapter below), if there still are available places.

### **CONFIRMATION OF STUDY PLACE AND ENROLMENT**

If you have been admitted through the ranking list, you must:

- 1) select the degree course in the Application portal and pay with one of the indicated payment methods to confirm the study place within **13 September 2024, 12 (midday)**. The first instalment of tuition fees amounts to € 773.00.
- 2) until **15 October 2024, 12 (midday)**, enrol online in the Application portal.

If you do not respect the deadlines, you will automatically lose your place which will be offered to the subsequent applicant in the ranking list.

If by paying the 1<sup>st</sup> instalment you have confirmed the study place, there will be no refund of the tuition fees.

According to national regulations, simultaneous enrolment in a maximum of 2 programmes is possible (however, the two programmes must not belong to the same class, e.g., LM-18/LM-18 and must differ for at least 2/3 of the course activities).

If you have been admitted to more than one study programme, you can confirm your place for a maximum of 2 programmes by paying the designated fee twice.

If you do not have the required academic qualification, you will be given a conditional offer for a study place, and you must submit your qualification upon enrolment. If you achieve your qualification after the enrolment deadline, you cannot enrol, and you will lose your place which will be offered to the subsequent applicant in the ranking list.

Advice: If you achieve your qualification after the enrolment deadline, you should not pay the tuition fees to confirm the study place. You will be able to submit a late enrolment request and, only if there are study places still available, you can enrol by 13 December 2024.

If you have been admitted in the ranking list, but you do not possess a valid admission qualification, you can be excluded with Rector's decree even after enrolment.

**Please note** that you do not gain full student status by only paying the tuition fees. This status will only be acquired upon enrolment.

### **INFORMATION FOR INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS**

If you have gained your qualification abroad, you must upload in the Application portal (if not uploaded upon application):

- the diploma of your qualification;
- the official translation of your diploma into Italian (translation is not necessary if the certificates have been issued in German or English);
- the Diploma supplement, where it must be indicated:
  - that you have achieved at least 180 credit points (ECTS) and
  - that the study title gives access to a Master programme.

If you have gained your qualification abroad in one of the Countries that are signatory to the Lisbon Convention you must also upload:

- the Statement of Correspondence of your qualification, to be downloaded from the ARDI - Automatic Recognition Database – Italy

If you have gained your qualification abroad in a country that is not a signatory to the Lisbon Convention, you must also upload:

- the Statement of Comparability and Verification of your qualification, issued by the Italian Information Centre on Academic Mobility and Equivalence (CIMEA)

unibz performs the necessary checks on your foreign qualification and in case of doubt reserves the right to request additional documents.

Please note: If you have gained your qualification abroad and have not uploaded your diploma, you are provisionally admitted until your study title can be verified. You will be excluded if it turns out after verification that your qualification does not meet the requirements and therefore does not permit enrolment.

**Please note:** If you have declared to be resident in Italy but have not attached to your application a copy of your valid residence permit for Italy (see article 39, paragraph 5 of decree no. 286 of 25.07.1998) you will be excluded from the rank list.
